## Section 3A

### 3A-1. SQUADDING:

There will be two relays squadded for the Smallbore Rifle Championships and, competitors will be assigned to the same targetthroughout each Championship.

No one will be allowed to set-up on the firing line after the end of the 3-minute preparation period.

All competitors will complete each fired match before the next fired match is started. There is no lunch break.

The Special Squadding Form, available on-line, through the NRA Competitive Shooting Division, Rifle Department, will be used for those competitors who wish special squadding.

\*\*\*A fee of \$20.00 is assessed for each Special Squadding Form (not per competitor) submitted.\*\*\*

Application for Special Squadding does not guarantee desired firing points and requests for special squadding not submitted on the Special Request Form will not be honored.

Disables shooters will not be charged a Special Squadding fee.

### 3A-2. FIRING SCHEDULE:

### 3A-3. PRACTICE FIRING:

Practice firing will be on the same firing point as assigned for the respective championship. No more than two practice relays per competitor.

### 3A-4. RIFLE HANDLING:

Competitors will NOT bring their rifles to the firing line until instructed to do so by the Range Personnel (Tower).

### 3A-5. EMPTY CHAMBER INDICATOR:

Will be required for all rifles except on the firing line after the preparation period is started until finished firing for that stage.

- a. Service and Civilian Class and Category Awards Class and category awards will be given in all NRA individual fired and aggregate matches. Competitors entering the Service or Civilian categories will be divided into classes and those classes further divided into the Service and Civilian categories.

Awards will be provided on the basis of 5 or more competitors in a class/category in the following manner:

Minimum of five competitors in a class/category, one award; 15 competitors, 2 awards; 25 competitors, 3 awards; and following this procedure until the total number of competitors within a class/category is established, on the basis of one award for each 10 competitors.

When there are fewer than five competitors within a class/category they will be combined within the class as shown below until a total of five or more is achieved.

Civilian > Junior > Service  
Junior > Civilian > Service  
Service > Civilian > Junior

In no case will any competitors of lower classification be combined with the Master Class.

- b. Junior, Intermediate Junior and Sub-Junior Class and Category Awards. Class and category awards will be given in all fired and aggregate matches.

# NRA Smallbore Rifle Position Championship

Competitors entering the Junior, Intermediate Junior or Sub-Junior categories will be divided into classes and those classes further divided into the Junior, intermediate Junior and Sub-Junior categories.

One award will be provided if there are 5 or more competitors in a class/category. An additional award will be provided as above. When there are fewer than five competitors within class/category, they will be combined with the other Junior categories as shown below, until a minimum of five competitors is achieved:

Sub-Junior > Intermediate > Junior  
Intermediate > Junior > Sub-Junior  
Junior > Intermediate > Sub-Junior

If there are still fewer than 5 competitors within a class when all Junior categories within the class have been combined, the categories will be combined with the next higher class.

NOTE: Competitors of lower classifications will not be combined with the Master class.

d. Awards will be provided based on the basis of the actual number of scores fired in each match.

### 3B-3. TEAM AWARD DISTRIBUTION:

NRA Visa Gift Cards are issued based on the number of authorized firing members. When provided for by the match conditions, plaques or medals will be awarded to each firing member of the team and sponsoring club or organization.

### 3B-4. SMALLBORE TEAM AWARDS SCHEDULE:

#### Place Awards:

WINNER: As specified in match conditions  
SECOND: NRA silver tone medals and 9 Award Points per firing member  
THIRD: NRA bronze tone medals and 7 Award Points per firing member  
HIGH JUNIOR TEAM: As specified in match conditions

#### Class/Category Awards:

WINNER: 10 Award Points per firing member  
SECOND: 9 Award Points per firing member

THIRD AND BELOW: 8 Award Points per firing member

All teams will be divided into classes, and further divided into categories to determine awards as follows:

NRA Affiliated Local Club (Rule 2.11)  
NRA Affiliated Open Club (Rule 2.11)  
Junior Club (Rule 2.18)  
Junior Open Club (Rule 2.18)  
Service (Rule 2.13)  
State Association (Rule 2.12)  
State Association Junior (Rules 2.12 and 2.3)

Teams winning place awards are not eligible for class/category awards, but will be counted in order to compute the number of class/category awards to be made.

There must be two or more teams in order to establish one award in a class/category. Five teams will provide 2nd place; 8 teams, 3rd place; 13 teams, 4th place and so on until the final number of award places is established.

If there is only one team within a class/category, that team will be combined within the class as shown below until a total of two or more teams is achieved:

Local Club > State Assn. > Open Club > Service > Local Jr. Club > Jr. St. Assn. > Open Jr. Club

Open Club > Service > St. Assn. > Local Club > Open Jr. Club > Jr. St. Assn > Local Jr. Club

State Assn. > Local Club > Open Club > Service > Jr. St. Assn. > Local Jr. Club > Open Jr. Club

Open Jr. Club > Jr. St. Assn. > Local Jr. Club > State Assn. > Open Club > Local Club > Service

Open Jr. Club > Jr. St. Assn > Local Jr. Club > State Assn > Open Club > Local Club > Service

If a total of two or more teams cannot be achieved by combining within the same class, the team involved will be moved up to the next higher class within the same category and then to the next appropriate category until the minimum of two teams is achieved. Teams of lower classification will not be combined with the Master Class.

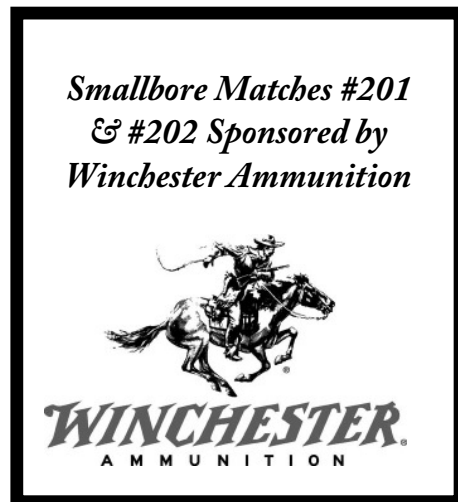
