

BILLY C. ATKINS TROPHY



The Billy C. Atkins Trophy is a wooden pentagon with the emblem of each of the five U.S. Services (Army, Navy, Coast Guard, Marine Corps, Air Force) on the points. Inside the pentagon is a relief scene of a service rifle shooter at Camp Perry. The trophy is named after its donor and constructed by Richard Greeves of Fort Washakie, WY.
