

CENTENARY TROPHY



The Centenary Trophy is a sterling silver tankard which was a gift to the National Rifle Association of America from the National Rifle Association of Great Britain on the occasion of the 1971 firing of the Palma Trophy Match at Camp Perry and the centennial year of the National Rifle Association. The trophy was first offered in competition in 1982 for the winner of the Palma Aggregate Match, and renamed the Centenary Trophy Palma Aggregate in 1990.

Match Conditions:

- 1982 The aggregate of scores fired in the Army Cup (20 shots, slow fire, 600 yards, prone); Air Force Cup (20 shots, slow fire, 600 yards, prone); Crowell Trophy (20 shots, slow fire, 600 yards, prone); Leech Cup (unlimited practice and 20 shots for record in 30 minutes, 1000 yards, prone, metallic sights) and the Palma Individual Match (two sighting shots and 15 shots each at 800, 900 and 1000 yards, prone).
- 1984 Course of fire changed to delete the Leech Cup, making a possible score of 1050.
- 1995 Course of fire changed to delete the Leech Cup and Palma Individual, making a possible score of 600.
