

COAST GUARD TROPHY



The Coast Guard Trophy is a bronze statuette of Alexander Hamilton, first Secretary of the Treasury and founder of the Coast Guard. The statuette is a miniature reproduction of the statue which stands at the South Gate of the Treasury Department in Washington, D.C. The trophy was donated by the U.S. Coast Guard to the NRA in 1930.

Match Conditions:

- 1930 The high-scoring competitor in a rapid fire match consisting of 10 shots, 200 yards, kneeling or sitting from standing and 10 shots, 300 yards prone from standing with the Service Rifle.
- 1940 A rapid fire match consisting of 10 shots 200 yards, kneeling or sitting from standing with the Service Rifle.
- 1953 A rapid fire match consisting of 20 shots, 200 yards, sitting/kneeling with the Service Rifle.
- 1968 Conditions changed to allow the use of either Service or NRA Match Rifle.
- 1976 A rapid fire match consisting of 30 shots, 200 yards kneeling or sitting from standing with the Service Rifle or NRA Match Rifle.
- 1978 Course of fire as before but reduced to 20 shots.
