

CROWELL TROPHY



The Crowell Trophy is a bronze statuette by Charles Schreyvogel entitled "The Last Drop." The statuette represents a U.S. Cavalryman of the last quarter of the 19th century emptying his canteen into his hat so that his horse can drink. The trophy was donated to the NRA in 1925 by the Honorable Benedict Crowell of Cleveland, OH, Assistant Secretary of War, 1917 to 1920.

Match Conditions:

1925	A match consisting of 15 shots, slow fire, prone at 1000 yards with the Service Rifle of any nation represented. In 1925, the Crowell Trophy was the 1000 yard stage of the Palma Individual Match.
1927	15 shots, 1000 yards, part of the Palma Individual.
1931	10 shots at 600 yards, prone, under the same conditions. Removed from the Palma Individual Aggregate.
1951	Awarded to the winner of Division B (Service Rifle) of the Members' Match. 20 shots for record, slow fire, 600 yards, with the Service Rifle.
1953	A slow fire match consisting of 20 shots, 600 yards, prone, with the NRA Match Rifle or Service Rifle.
1963	The course of fire as before, but restricted to the manually-operated NRA Match Rifle.
1971	Awarded to the high-scoring Senior shooter using the NRA Match Rifle in the National High Power Rifle Championship Aggregate.
1978	Returned to the conditions of 1953.
