

DUPONT TROPHY



The DuPont Trophy is a European bronze casting which depicts a mediaeval military bowman with arrow drawn, ready for its flight. The trophy is over three feet tall and was donated to the NRA in 1923 by the E.I. DuPont de Nemours Company. The DuPont Trophy is awarded annually to the high scoring competitor in the aggregate of the NRA High Power Service National Championships.

Match Conditions:

- 1923 An individual fired match consisting of 20 shots standing, 20 shots kneeling and 20 shots prone, all at 300 meters, with the Free Rifle.
- 1935 An aggregate of scores fired in the Coast Guard Trophy, Navy Cup, Wimbledon Cup, Marine Corps Cup, Crowell Trophy, U.S. Trophy Smallbore, Winchester Trophy Smallbore, Clarke Memorial Trophy Pistol, Service Pistol Slow, Timed and Rapid Fire Matches.
- 1937 A aggregate of Coast Guard Trophy, Navy Cup, Wimbledon Cup, Marine Corps Cup, first half of Preliminary Smallbore Dewar and Clarke Memorial Pistol Matches.
- 1940 The Service Rifle Team Match (M1 Rifle)--10 firing members, two alternates, Team Captain and Coach. Course of fire was eight shots per firing member at 600 yards prone.
- 1951 The NRA Service Rifle National Championship--Aggregate of Navy Cup, Scott Trophy, Marine Corps Cup and President's Matches (90 shots).
- 1954 The NRA Service Rifle National Championship--Aggregate of Navy Cup, Coast Guard Trophy, Service Rifle Rapid Fire, Marine Corps Cup, Crowell Trophy and President's Match (130 shots).
- 1957 The NRA Service Rifle National Championship--Aggregate of Navy Cup, Coast Guard Trophy, Service Rifle Rapid Fire, Members' Trophy, Crowell Trophy, The President's Match and Marine Corps Cup Matches (150 shots).
- 1958 The NRA Service Rifle National Championship--Aggregate of Navy Cup, Coast Guard Trophy, Marine Corps Cup, Members' Trophy and Crowell Trophy Matches (100 shots).
- 1960 The NRA Service Rifle National Championship--Aggregate of President's Match, Marine Corps Cup, Members' Trophy, Coast Guard Trophy, Crowell Trophy and Navy Cup Matches (130 shots).
- 1962 The NRA Service Rifle National Championship--Aggregate of President's Match, Marine Corps

Cup, Air Force Cup, Coast Guard Trophy and Nevada Trophy Matches (160 shots).

- 1963 The NRA Service Rifle National Championship--Aggregate of President's Match, Navy Cup, Coast Guard Trophy, Marine Corps Cup, Air Force Cup, Nevada Trophy and Army Cup Matches (160 shots).
- 1968 The NRA Service Rifle National Championship--Aggregate of Members' Trophy, Scott Trophy, Coast Artillery Trophy, Army Cup, Navy Cup, Coast Guard Trophy, Marine Corps and Air Force Cup Matches (160 shots).
- 1976 The NRA Service Rifle National Championship--Aggregate of those matches listed for 1968 but 200 shots.
- 1978 The NRA Service Rifle National Championship--Aggregate of Members' Trophy, Scott Trophy, Coast Artillery Trophy, Army Cup, Navy Cup, Coast Guard Trophy, Marine Corps Cup, Air Force Cup, Crescent Cup, Appreciation Cup, Cavalry Cup and Crowell Trophy Matches (240 shots).
