

# FARR TROPHY



The Farr Trophy is an ornate, two-handled, unlidged silver cup placed in competition by the NRA in 1922 to commemorate the long run of 70 consecutive bullseyes fired with the Service Rifle in 1921 in the 1000 yard Wimbledon Match by 71 year old Mr. George R. Farr.

## Match Conditions:

- 1922 The high-scoring competitor firing the Service Rifle in the Wimbledon Match during the National Matches.
- 1979 Made a separately entered match, but still fired concurrently with the Wimbledon Match over the same course of fire. As in the Wimbledon, winner is determined by shootoff among the high-scoring competitors from each relay.
