

# PALMA INDIVIDUAL TROPHY



The Palma Individual Trophy is a large, long-stemmed silver cup. Detailed miniature silver replicas of the 1903 Service Rifle are stacked around the stem. The cup is mounted on a circular wooden base which has silver medallions affixed around its perimeter. The trophy was presented in 1908 by the National Guard Association of the United States.

## Match Conditions:

1913	An individual fired match consisting of 15 shots, 800 yards; 15 shots, 1000 yards with the Service Rifle of any nation represented in the match.
1928	An aggregate of the scores fired in the Wright, Scott and Crowell matches.
1931-51	NO COMPETITION
1958	Awarded to the high-scoring Civilian competitor in National Service Rifle Championships -- an aggregate of Navy Cup, Coast Guard, Marine Corps Cup, Members' Trophy and Crowell Trophy Matches (100 shots).
1960	An aggregate of President's Match, Marine Corps Cup Match, Members' Trophy, Coast Guard Trophy, Crowell Trophy and Navy Cup Matches (130 shots).
1962	An aggregate of President's, Marine Corps Cup, Air Force Cup, Coast Guard Trophy, Crowell Trophy, Navy Cup and Nevada Trophy Match (160 shots).
1963	An aggregate of President's Match, Marine Corps Cup, Air Force Cup, Coast Guard Trophy, Army Cup, Navy Cup and Nevada Trophy Matches.
1968	An aggregate of Members' Trophy, Scott Trophy, Coast Artillery, Army Cup, Navy Cup, Coast Guard Trophy, Marine Corps Cup and Air Force Cup Matches.
1970	Competitor firing the highest score in the Palma Trophy Team selection aggregate of Army Cup, Air Force Cup and the Leech Cup Matches.
1976	Awarded to the highest-scoring individual U.S. competitor in the Palma International Team Match, 15 shots slow fire prone at 800, 900 and 1000 yards.
1978	Awarded to the high-scoring competitor in the Palma Individual Match, a fired match consisting of 15 shots slow fire prone at 800 yards, 900 yards and 1000 yards.
