

VIKING TROPHY



The Viking Trophy is a sterling silver miniature of an ancient Viking boat approximately 7 inches high and 11-1/2 inches long set on a wooden base. The trophy was presented to the United States Shooting Team by the Norwegian Sports Shooting Federation during the 1952 World Shooting Championships held in Oslo, Norway. Dedicated by NRA in 1978 for International competitions.

Awarded to the NRA International Indoor Free Pistol Champion.
