

THE SHAFFER TROPHY



The Shaffer Trophy is an engraved single shot 7.7mm Schuetzen Rifle made in Germany early 1900. The Rifle was donated by LTC C.J. Shaffer, a former NRA Competition Division Staff Manager, Director of Civilian Marksmanship and Executive Officer at Camp Perry while with the Army.

This trophy is awarded to the high scoring individual in the NRA Black Powder Position Target Rifle Championships.

Match Conditions:

1998 Twice over the course of: Ten shots standing at 200 yards, 10 shots sitting w/cross sticks at 300 yards and 10 shots prone w/cross sticks at 600 yards with a single shot, black powder cartridge rifle with period sights.
