

MELARAGNO TROPHY



The Melaragno Trophy is awarded to the National Intercollegiate Women's Air Pistol Champion. The trophy contents is a Lalique Champs Eleysee bowl with etched, sculptured leaves that blend with the natural flow of the body of the bowl. The base upon which the bowl sits is an elliptical pier made with sixteen facets that serve to mount the dedication plaque and names of winners. This trophy was presented to the NRA in 1999 by MIT Alumni / Alumnae, in recognition of "Pat" Melaragno, the MIT Pistol Coach from 1977-1996, for his contribution to collegiate shooting.

Match Conditions:

1999 Awarded to the Women's Air Pistol Champion at the NRA Intercollegiate Pistol Championships. Course of fire is 40 shots, 1 hour, 15 min., including sighters. A separate final will be conducted to include the top eight shooters.
