

VOLUNTEER TROPHY



The Volunteer Trophy was donated by the NRA Volunteers who serve during the annual National Rifle & Pistol Championships conducted at Camp Perry, Ohio. This is a bronze sculpture of the Niagara, a two masted ship used in the war of 1812, mounted on a wooden base, with plates all around for engraving.

The sculpture was made by Mary Maguire, a 35 year Camp Perry volunteer.

Award Conditions:

- 2007 Awarded in each of the three phases (Pistol, Smallbore Rifle, and High Power Rifle) during the National Rifle & Pistol Championships fired each year at Camp Perry, Ohio.
- 2008 Smallbore Position target changed to the NRA A-23/5 target.
